MUNICIPAL SERVICES BUSINESS

- Officers issued 6 warnings, 25 tickets, and conducted 52 investigations.
- Targeted Speed Enforcement Initiative took over three days and resulted in the issuance of 20 warnings and 65 tickets. 23 tickets were issued for Speeding with the highest speed recorded being 98 Km/H in the 50Km/H construction zone with workers present.
- Bicycle patrols continue on County pathways, partner communities, and campgrounds (Emerson Bridge Park, Rolling Hills Reservoir, and Crawling Valley Reservoir). 10 of 20 planned patrols for 2026 have been completed to date.
- Two 2 Bike Rodeos were held in June in Tilley and Alcoma School in Rainier.
- Dust Abatement is complete (June 9 - 26).
- JBS Access/Township Road 192N/HWY 873 construction continues with work at the Hwy 873 intersection.
- Line painting is complete.
- Lake Newell Resort Lift Station Electrical Upgrades was awarded, work is expected to begin in August.

PLANNING & DEVELOPMENT REPORT

- Jan 1 - June 30: 61 development permit applications were received and processed.
- Notable development includes: vehicle services business that assembles classic vehicles & motorcycles, auto wrecking & salvage yard, construction of additional shop space for an existing business, and an aerial spraying business at the Bassano Airport.
- Council approved three new Land Use amendments
